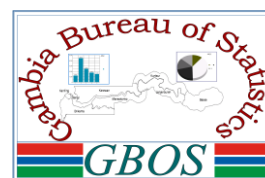

In September 2010, the overall consumer Price Index was 129.34, a 0.69 percent increase over the August 2010 overall index of 128.58

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 6.23 percent from September 2009 to September 2010. Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages increased by 8.23 percent whilst Non Food Products and Services rose by 2.92 percent.

Comparing September 2009 to September 2010, within the Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages, *Sugar, jam, honey and sweets* increased by 72.33 Percent, *Vegetable, root crops and tubers* increased by 16.07 percent, *Meat* increased by 6.19 percent and *Milk, Cheese and Egg* increased by 3.97 Percent.

For the Non Food items, the major increases were recorded by *Transport* and *Hotel and Restaurants* which rose by 24.30 percent and 9.40 percent respectively. Other marginal contributors to the increase were the *miscellaneous goods and services sub group* and *electricity, gas and other fuel sub group*.

During the months of August 2010 to September 2010, *Fish and fish products* sub-group show the highest increase of 0.59 percent, whilst *bread and cereals* went up by 0.56 primarily due increase in price of bread and rice. Oil and fats *products* registered an increase of 0.53 percent.

Annual Inflation Rate

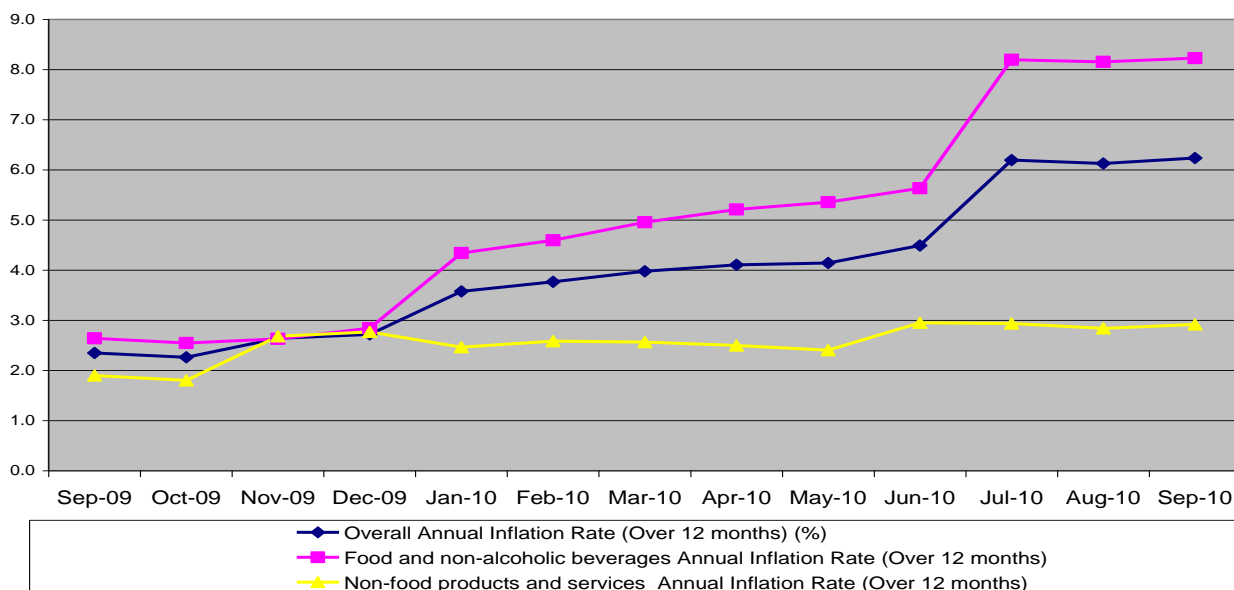
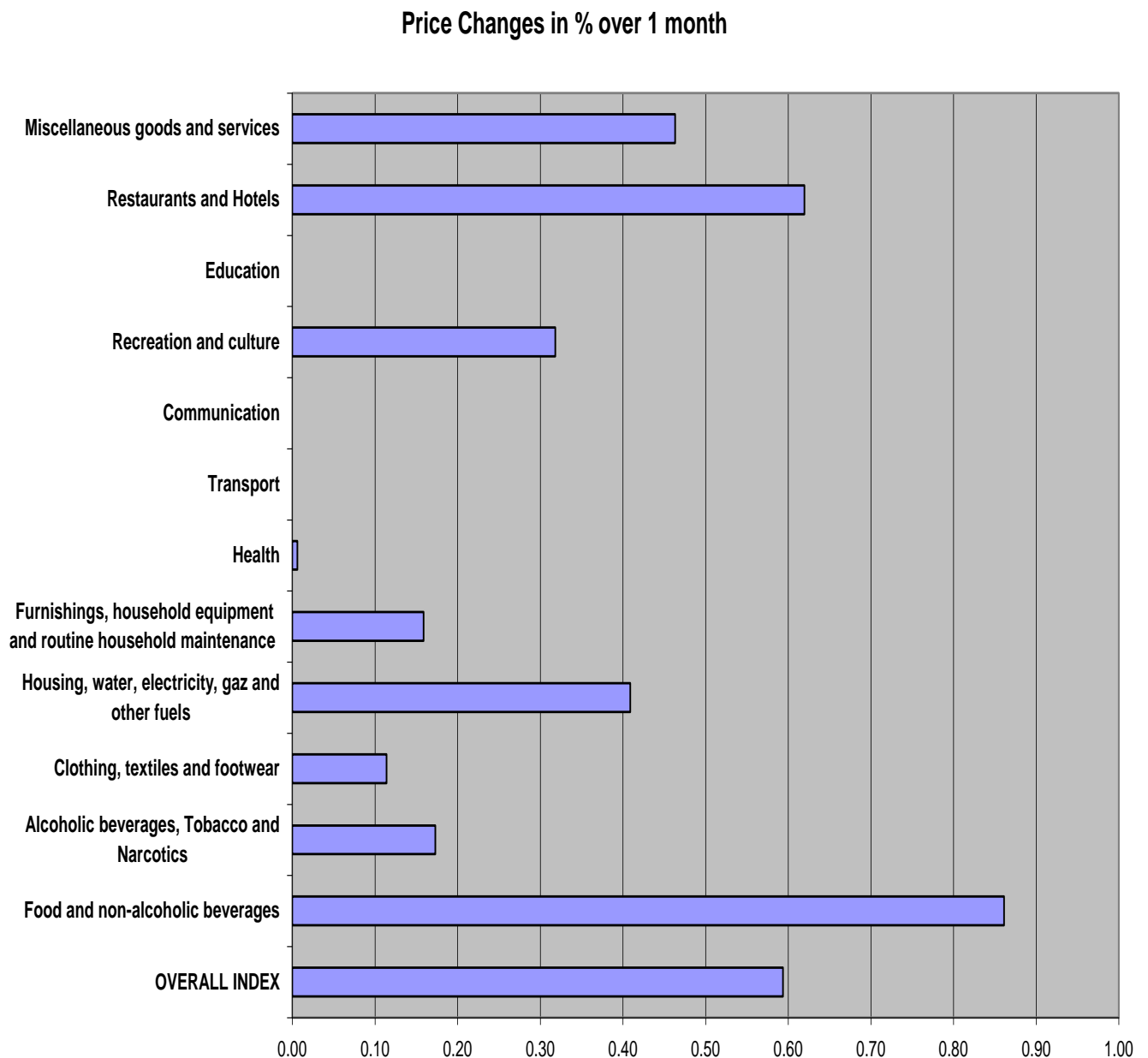


Figure 2. Monthly changes – Comparison with the previous month: August 2010 to August 2010
