In September 2017, the overall Consumer Price Index was 195.02, a 0.45 percent increase over the August 2017 overall index of 190.15

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 7.59 percent from September 2016 to September 2017. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 8.09 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 6.72 percent.

From September 2016 to September 2017, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, ‘Fish and fish products’ increased by 11.59 percent, ‘Meat and meat products’ increased by 10.92 percent, ‘Fruits and Nuts’ increased by 9.24 percent and ‘Bread and Cereal’ increased by 7.88 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by ‘Footwear’, ‘Clothing, Garments and tailoring services’ and ‘Electricity, Gas and other Fuels’ which rose by 10.12 percent, 7.23 percent and 5.60 percent respectively.

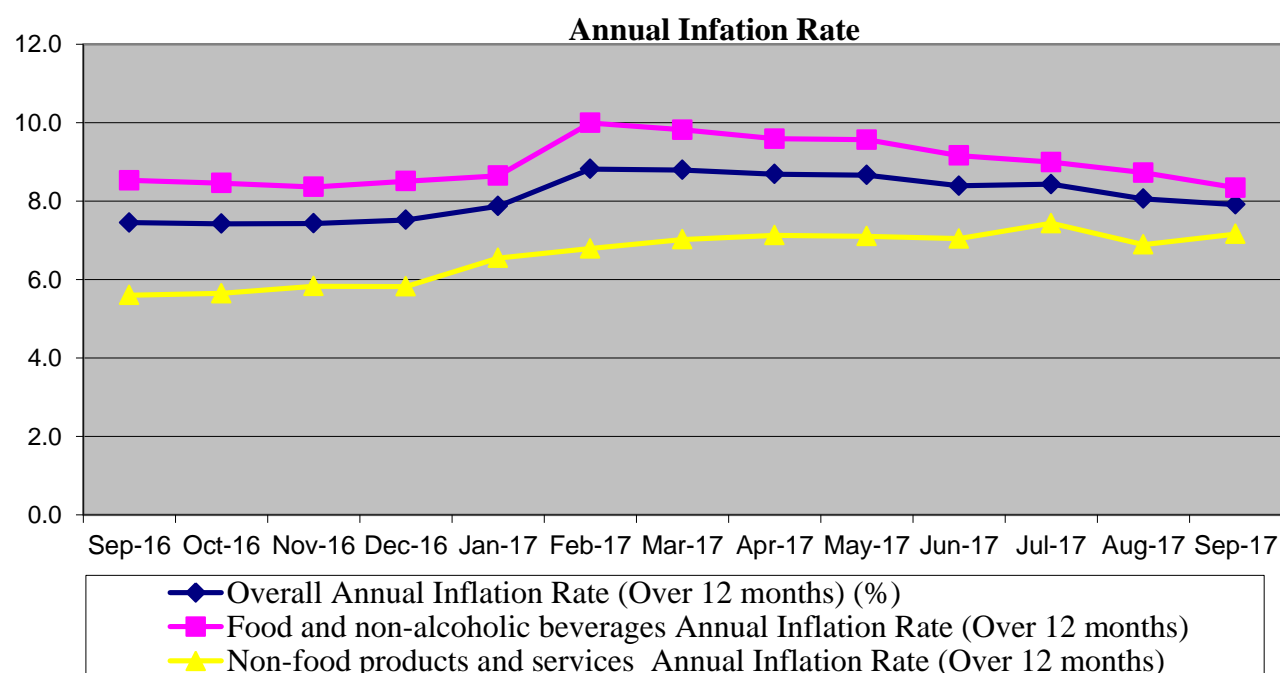
During the months of August 2017 to September 2017, ‘Fish and fish products’, ‘Meat and meat products’ and ‘Fruits and Nuts’ shows the highest increase in percentage with 0.90 percent, 0.81 percent, and 0.81 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 8.18 percent in September 2017 compared to 8.17 percent recorded in August 2017.

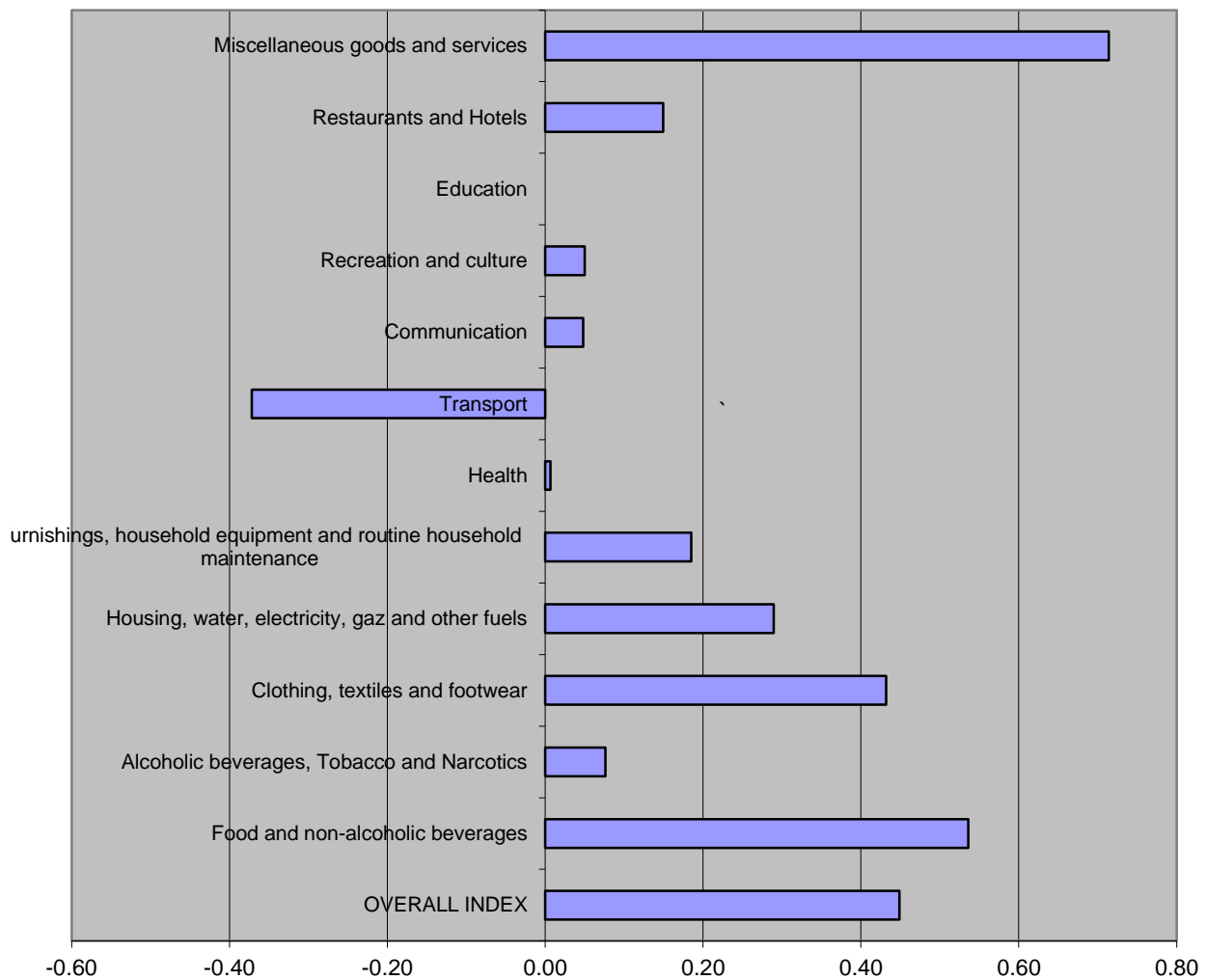
