The January 2015 inflation rate measured on year on year basis, that is between January 2014 and January 2015 went up by 7.01 percent. Some prices for both Food and Non-food items had gone up. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 8.41 whilst Non-Food products and Services rose by 4.74 percent.

From January 2014 to January 2015, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, ‘Meat and meat products’ increased by 21.74 percent ‘Milk, Cheese and Eggs’ 7.72 percent, ‘Oils and Fats’ 6.84 percent and ‘Fish and Fish products’ 6.75

For the Non-Food items, the major increases were recorded by ‘Health’ and ‘Transport’ which rose by 27.08 percent and 8.81 percent respectively. The rise in the ‘Health’ sector was due to the increase in consultation and admission fees during January 2014 whilst the ‘Transport’ index increase is due to the recent increase of the fuel pump price.

During the month of December 2014 to January 2015, the ‘Meat and Meat products’ show the highest increase of 0.83 percent, followed by ‘Fish and Fish products’ with 0.74 percent increase, whilst the ‘Milk, Cheese and Eggs’ increased by 0.23 percent. ‘Oils and Fats’ registered an increase of 0.21 percent as well.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation shows an increase, recording 6.09 percent during January 2015 compared to 5.9 percent which was recorded for December 2015.

Figure1. Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year. (January 2014 - January 2015)

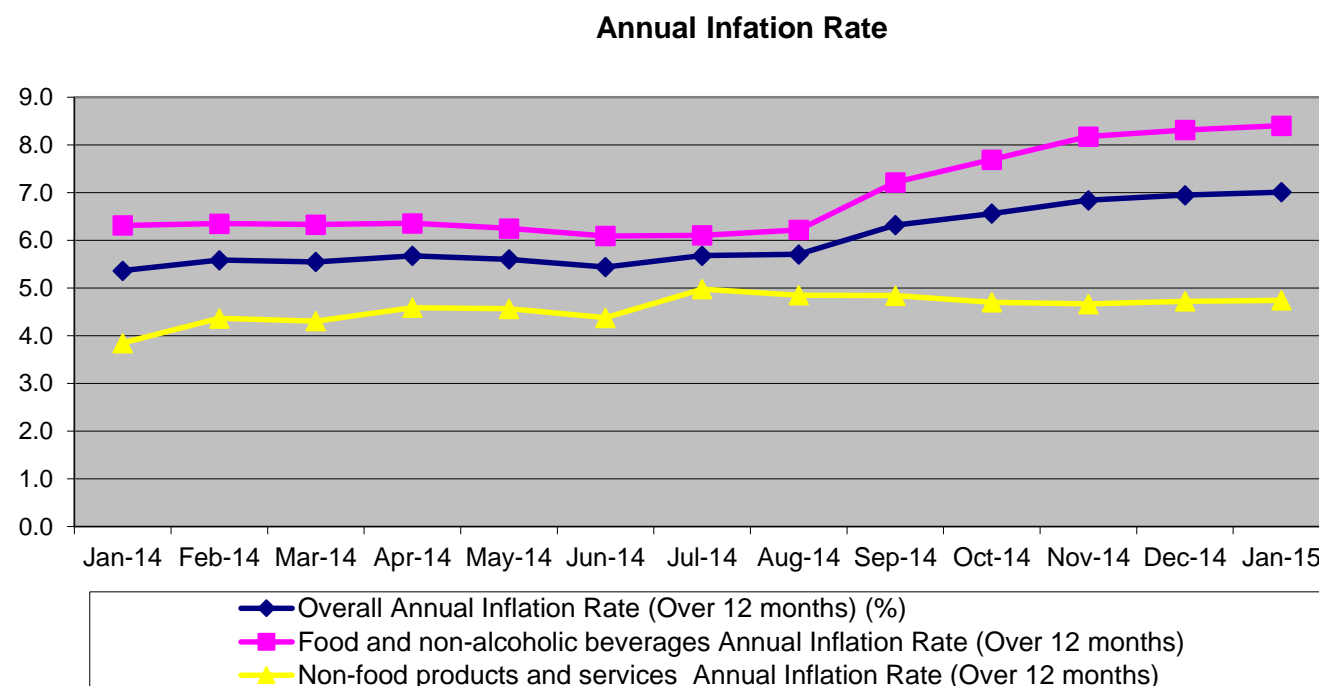
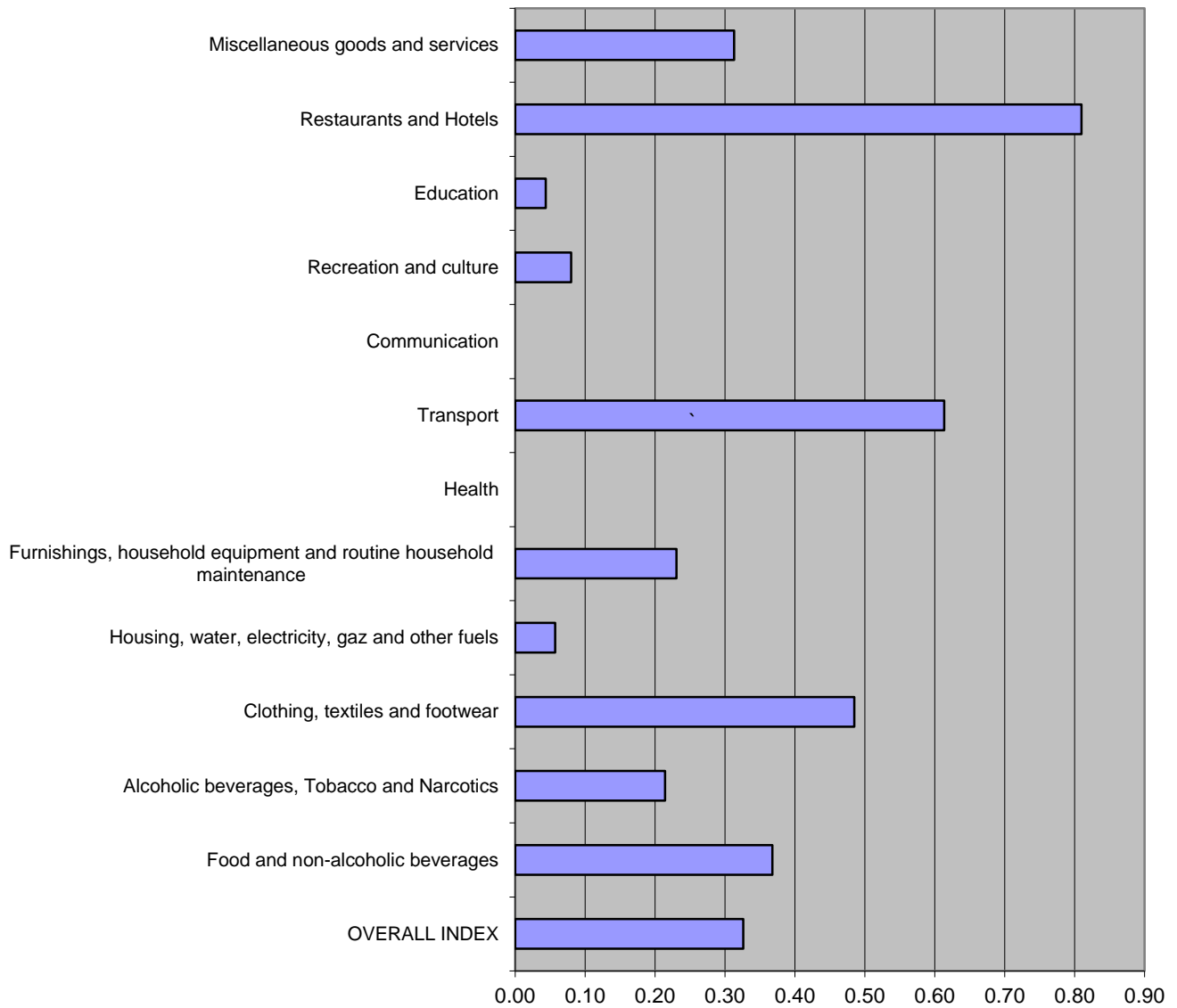


Figure 2. Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: December 2014 to January 2015
